If you phone, you will need to establish your identity by providing details of three of the following items:

- your date of birth
- your business, residential, postal or email address (maximum of one address)
- your bank account number (BSB number not required), and/or
- details from a Tax Office generated notice (maximum of two different notices, for example, the sequence number from any notice of assessment issued to you).

To assist with your enquiry you may also quote your TFN. It is not an offence not to quote your TFN but quoting it reduces the risk of administrative errors that may delay the processing of your enquiry.

If you would like another person such as a friend, family member or tax practitioner to update your details on your behalf, they must be listed as an authorised contact on vour account.
